



II Dolphins Sailing - Frequently Asksed Questions

Which ASA sailing classes does II Dolphins Sailing offer? II Dolphins Sailing is ASA Certified to teach BKB-101 Basic Keelboat, BCC-103 Basic Coastal Cruising, BBC-104 Intermediate Coastal Cruising/Bareboat Chartering, CON-105 Coastal Navigation and ACC-106 Advanced Coastal Cruising. All classes are taught on board II Dolphins.

When are classes offered? Our 2011 season will be a total of 5½ months beginning in the 2011 season; April, May, June, & September, October & November, no classes are offered in July & August. Days available for classes are in **black**. **Blue days** are booked classes with the number of spaces available in the class shown at the end of the line. There must be a minimum of **two per class** and a **50% deposit** to lock in the dates. If you are a single wanting a certain class, we can specify that on the calendar and pair you with another single and then agree on a class date. 101 and 103 classes are a minimum of two and maximum of four per class. 104 classes are a minimum and maximum of two per class. This very flexible schedule will allow anyone the opportunity to spread out classes on different weekends or combine weekdays with weekends to complete classes quicker by creating a long weekend.

What about classes on holidays? Due to the amount of holiday small boat traffic in the area, we do not offer classes on Memorial Day or Labor Day. No classes in July/August.

Which classes will save me the most money? Combo classes and families or couples who can fill up the boat (4 max), will get extra savings. Combo classes can be booked and then scheduled at different times throughout the spring and fall sailing season. **Full boat discounts of \$25 per person / per class will be given to those who fill the boat (4.)**

How do I book a class? 1) Check the 2011 Sailing Calendar for desired dates.
Black= open dates **Blue=** booked with slots available
2) Pick out the desired class(s) you are interested in
3) Print out the enrollment forms and follow the instructions
4) Send us an email and/or call to confirm class dates **before** mailing or faxing in the application.
5) Send in a 50% deposit with the application to lock in the class dates. Final balance due 30 days before start date.
6) Class materials will be mailed out with details regarding what and how to study and when and where to meet on the first day of your class.

What do I need to bring for the class? Details are on the application at the bottom.
